Our College library is open on all working days from 8.30 AM to 4.30 PM. The main activities include, switching ON the system, photostat machines, updating register & entering details of new books in the registers. Entry & exit register is maintained in the library for staffs and students.

Whenever a new book or CD arrives, librarian checks it, and ensures that all the pages are intact, complete and without any defect.

Anew letter is publishing every month from library committee.
