






OBSERVANCE OF WORLD HEMOPHILIA DAY




ACHIEVEMENTS

- Must meet equivalence certificate requirements from the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), if required.
- Proficiency in English is preferred (IELTS/TOEFL not compulsory but encouraged).

Application Process

1. Online Application via college website or Study in India portal.
2. Upload:
 - Academic transcripts
 - Passport copy
 - Proof of English proficiency(optional)
 - Medical fitness certificate
3. Pay Application Fee (if applicable).
4. Screening & Eligibility Check by Admissions Cell.
5. Provisional Admission Offer Letter issued.
6. Apply for Student Visa using this letter.
