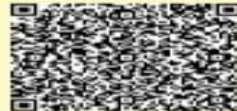

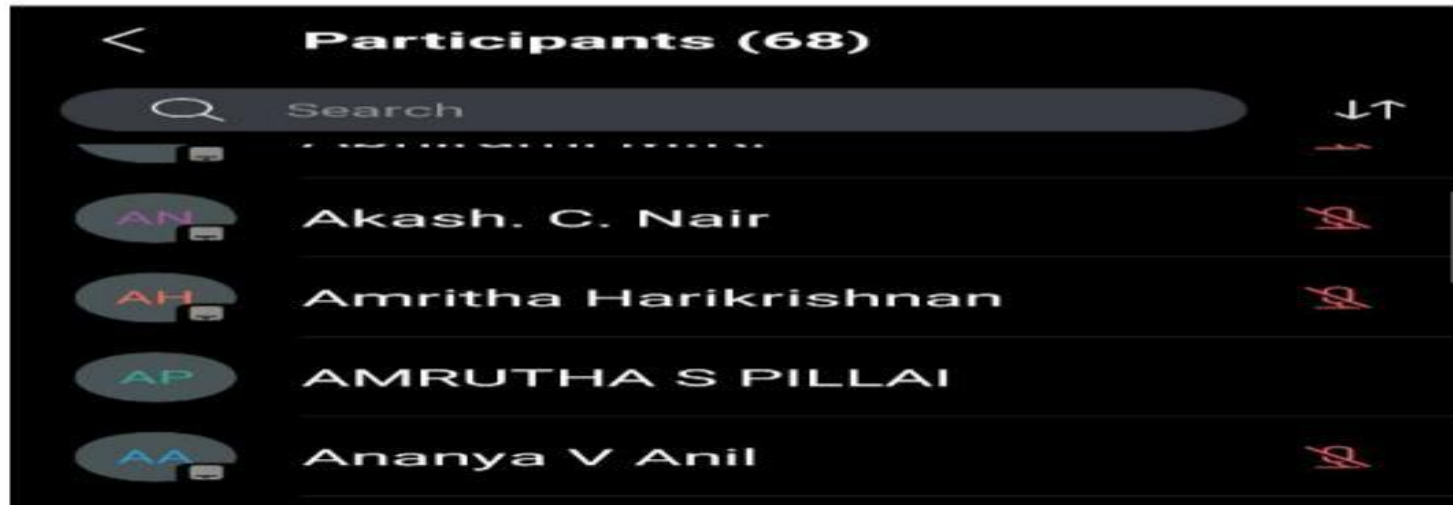
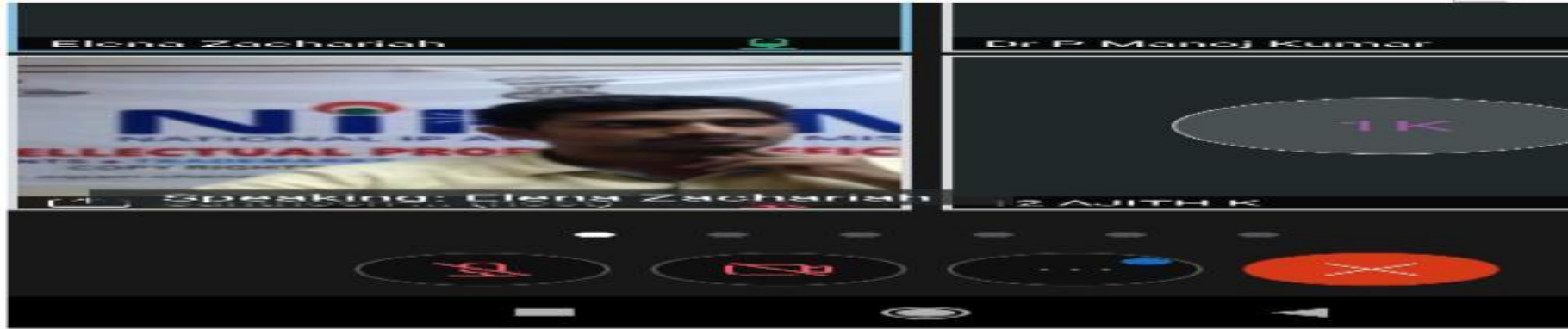

- On the occasion of the 75th anniversary of Independence, Government of India has launched the National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM) under the banner “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” to create widespread awareness on IPR in association with Intellectual Property Office, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Govt. of India.
- Intellectual Property Rights Information Centre – Kerala (IPRIC-K) functioning in KSCSTE, which is the Nodal Agency of the Kerala State for Intellectual Property Rights related matters and services is coordinating the activities under the Mission in Kerala in association with Patent Office, Chennai. Expression of Interest has been invited from the Higher Secondary Schools/Polytechnic Colleges/Science Colleges and Engineering Colleges in the State for conducting IPR awareness programmes under the Mission.
- It is proposed to conduct around 500 awareness programmes on IPR in the Kerala State under this Mission.
- The webinar was charted on 21st of February 2022 at 3.00-4.15pm.
- The Resource person named Sai Santhosh Kumar, B.tech electrical from IIT Dhanbad..experience as examiner of patents for the past 2 and half year,.also has prior working experience in automobile sector.

The event is held annually, encouraging individuals, communities, and businesses to turn off nonessential electric lights, for one hour, from 8:30 to 9:30 p.m. on a specific day towards the end of March, as a symbol of commitment to the planet.
- Earth Hour endeavours to spark global conversations on protecting nature not only because it is our strongest ally against the climate crisis – but also because of its importance in ensuring our own health, happiness, prosperity and even survival. Earth Hour asks people to turn their lights off for one hour.
- Our college also organised Earth hour campaign amongst all the students.
- As a part of the campaign, energy saving oath was taken and plants were handed over to the Herbal Committee (Mrs.Vaishna.V.Chandran, Ms.Anuraj.& Mrs. Sruthy) as a stepping stone to organic farming by the college CEO, Dr. Shaiju. David. Alfi Sir and Principal, Dr. P. Manoj Kumar Sir.

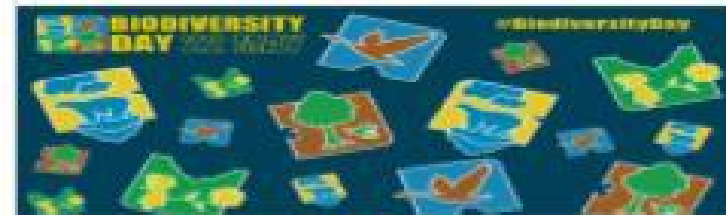
