2.2 - CATERING TO STUDENT DIVERSITY


<u>SPECIAL PROGRAMMES FOR ADVANCED LEARNERS AND SLOW</u> <u>LEARNERS</u>

In our institution in order to assess the slow learners Mentor Mentee system is there which is monitored by programme named Students Support Guidance Program (SSGP. The SSGP coordinator continuously assesses the performance of the students and tries to resolve the problems encountered during learning. The students are evaluated in terms of knowledge and skills. Our institution organizes an orientation program for newly admitted U.G. and P.G. students. Students are assessed continuously through regular teaching, interactions and regular viva by subject teachers. The slow learners are identified and are provided with the tutorial teaching. The students who get less than 50% marks continuously has been considered as a slow learner and given special attention to them during classes. The students with problems in the communication skill are identified and are counselled to attend the sessions, to improve their communication skill, conducted by the institute. The advanced learners are motivated by extra guidance provided by faculty through personal interactions. Students are motivated for better performance in competitive exams and for higher studies by mentors during mentoring sessions. Career guidance is provided for higher studies by the Training and Placement cell.

FUNCTIONS OF MENTORS

- The mentor shall meet the mentees regularly and record the outcome of the meeting.
- The details about each mentee will be recorded and periodically updated.
- The mentor shall identify the students performing exceptionally well in curricular or co-curricular activities and report to the head of the institution/department for providing further motivation to advanced/gifted learners.

- The mentor shall interact with the student and try to find out the reason for their difficulty to concentrate in studies
- Provide a guidance for students who may be facing problems in both academic and personal aspects
- Mentors should ensure that students are clear about the Course Structure, Evaluation system, attendance, and credits.
- The mentees are adviced to write their Class, Internal and End Semester Examinations Well.
- Mentors should share reports of the various issues raising by mentees with the HOD/Principal and the clarifications to the same are informed to the mentees by the mentors themselves
- The Mentor shall Keep a track of the attendance, academic performance and behavioural aspects of the students by interacting with exam department and the hostel authorities etc.
- The Mentor shall contact parents to inform the progress of their ward and maintain a record of the progress made by the identified underperforming students and take remedial actions wherever required.

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



REPORT FOR SPECIAL PROGRAMMES FOR SLOW PERFORMERS

- The institution always follows the words of our former president Dr.A.P.J Abdul Kalam:- "The best brains of the nation may be found on the last benches of the classroom".
- 2. The slow performers are supported in the classrooms by giving more attention to them.
- 3. Special class tests and viva voce are conducted regularly for such students.
- 4. Seminares are conducted for such students to improve their learning level and to boost their confidence to perform well.
- 5. The institution provides additional classes for the slow learners to capture the tough portions.
- 6. Assignments are given to the students regularly which help them to collect additional points on the respective topic.
- 7. Graphical videos are presented for the students to understand the mechanism of action of drugs, physiological process of the body, chemical reactions...etc.

- 8. Special vivas are conducted for the slow performers by giving them questions in advance, so that they can address the situation without fear.
- 9. Improvement exams are conducted for the students who get low marks in the internal examinations. This is a chance for those students to get more marks and study the portions repeatedly.
- 10. Each student has a mentor who takes care of them on behalf of their curricular and extracurricular activities.
- 11. Certain students are slow performers in their academic activities but are highly talented with some special skills in arts, sports...etc. The mentor and the class in-charges give special attention to improve their talents. This ultimately helps them to stand alone and to face the problems courageously. When they get confidence to face the problems, their academic performance also improves.
