RABIES - SLEEPLESS TERM IN KERALA

INTRODUCTION

A deadly virus spread to people from the saliva of infected animals. Rabies is usually transmitted through an animal bite, for example, from stray dogs. Rabies is a viral disease (Lyssavirus genus) that causes encephalitis in humans and other mammals.

DEFINITION

Rabies is a viral zoonotic disease that causes progressive and fatal inflammation of the brain and spinal cord.



Early **symptoms** can include fever and tingling at the site of exposure. These symptoms are followed by one or more of the following symptoms: nausea, vomiting, violent movements, uncontrolled excitement, hydrophobia, paralysis, confusion, and loss of consciousness.

Once symptoms appear, the result is virtually always death, regardless of treatment. The time period between contracting the disease and the start of symptoms is usually one to three months but can vary from less than one week to more than one year. The time depends on the distance the virus must travel along peripheral nerves to reach the central nervous system.

PREVENTION

- Animal control and vaccination programs have decreased the risk of rabies from dogs in a number of regions of the world.
- Immunizing people before they are exposed is recommended for those at

high risk, including those who work with bats or who spend prolonged periods in areas of the world where rabies is common.

In people who have been exposed to rabies, the rabies vaccine and sometimes rabies immunoglobulin are effective in preventing the disease, if the person receives the treatment before the start of rabies symptoms.

➤ Washing bites and scratches for 15 minutes with soap and water, povidine-iodine, or detergent may reduce the number of viral particles and may be somewhat effective at preventing transmission.

STAGES OF RABIES

Rabies virus causes acute infection of the central nervous system. Five general stages are recognized in humans:

- **4** Incubation
- prodrome,
- **♣** acute neurologic period,
- coma, and
- death (or very rarely recovery)

The **incubation period** is exceptionally variable, ranging from fewer than 10 days to longer than 2 years, but is usually 1–3 months.



TREATMENT

Treatment after exposure can prevent the disease if given within 10 days. The rabies vaccine is 100% effective if given early, and still has a chance of success if delivery is delayed. Every year, more than 15 million people get vaccinated after potential exposure. While this works well, the cost is significant.

In the US, it is recommended that people receive one dose of human rabies immunoglobulin (HRIG) and four doses of rabies vaccine over a 14-day period. HRIG is expensive and makes up most of the cost of post-exposure treatment, ranging as high as several thousand dollars. Efficient follow up is needed.

CONCLUSION

Public health education and awareness are still insufficient to contribute to national rabies control and prevention programs. Dog and wildlife populations control measures are still carried out with poor planning and lack of monitoring of its consequences. Vaccination of domestic animals remain limited in the Region and insufficient for the control of rabies. We should work together for the betterment of this condition.
