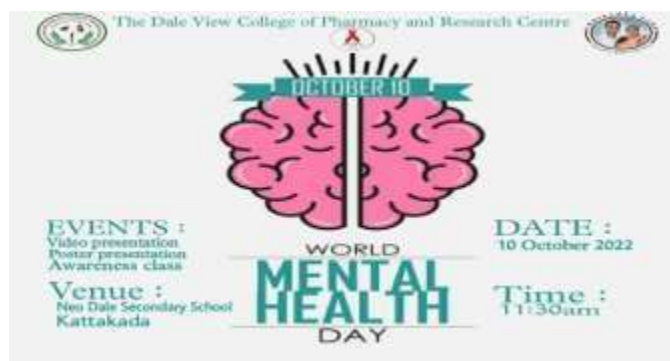

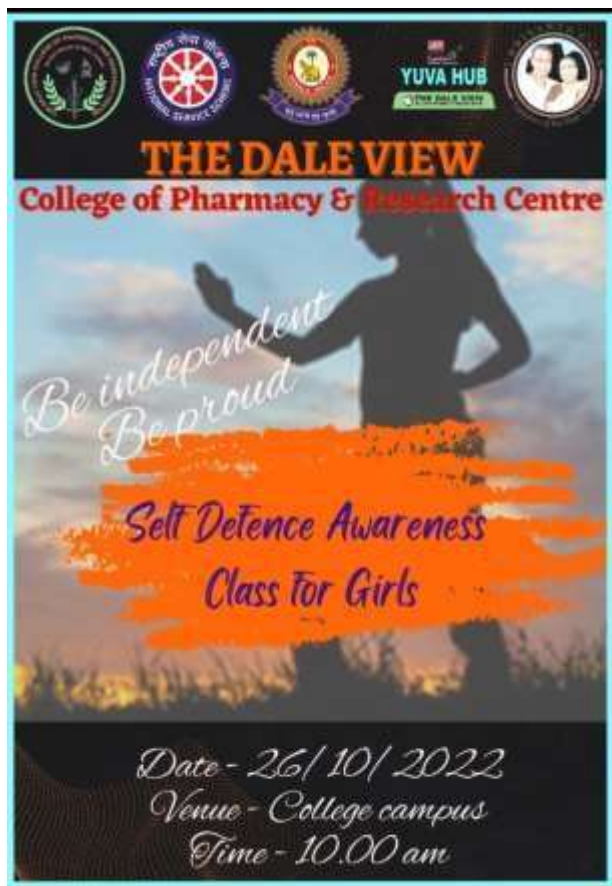
SELF DEFENCE AWARENESS CLASS
