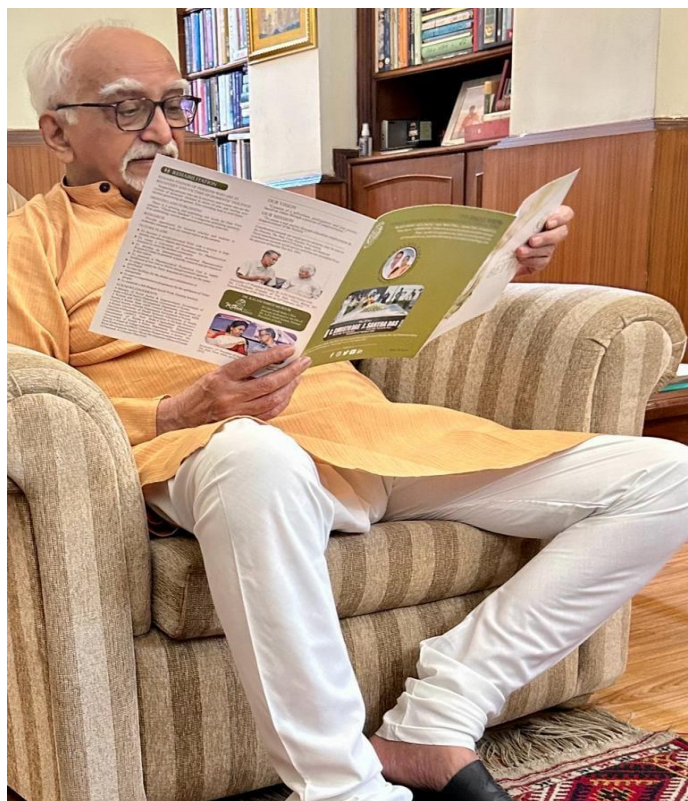

### World Heart Day CELEBRATION

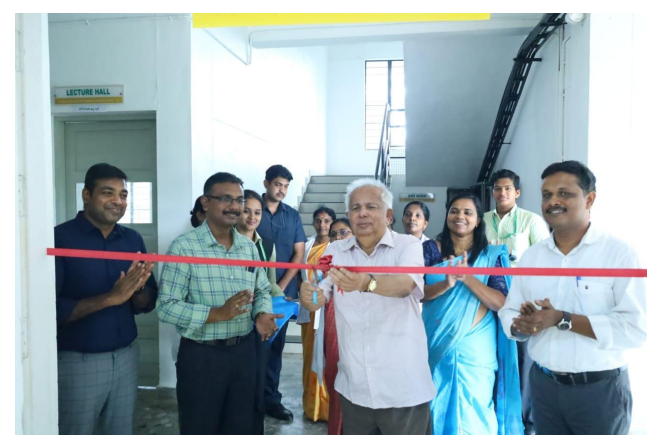
