



Rules & Regulations for Individual Events

Round 1 : Digital Storytelling



Topic : **Voices for Change : How Youth are Shaping the Future**

Description:

Young voices have the power to question, challenge, inspire, and lead. This digital storytelling competition encourages you to showcase the impact of youth-driven change through a creative and engaging narrative.

Participants are encouraged to tell real stories using video that reflect the role of youth in shaping a better tomorrow. This is your chance to give voice to the change makers of today who are building the future we dream of.

Submission Guidelines:

- ▶ Format: MP4, MOV, AVI
- ▶ Time: up to 2 minutes
- ▶ Language: English or regional languages
- ▶ Original content only. No pictures or AI generated videos, animated videos and already existing videos are not allowed to incorporate in the Reel.
- ▶ After finalizing the Reel, obtain a letter certified by the Head of the Institution affirming that the student prepared the Reel independently.
- ▶ Bring this letter to the competition venue.
- ▶ The Reel must be recorded using a mobile phone and Avoid any dangerous situations during filming.
- ▶ Save the Reel file with Name of the Student and College.
The reel should be submitted in a pendrive on the day of the competition.

Round 2 : 120 Seconds of Fame - Quick Talk Challenge



Description:

Like a live RJ, participants speak for not more than 2 minutes on a given topic with a smooth, engaging tone.

Topic : **Pitch for Progress**

Description:

Participants have to identify real-world challenges and present creative, feasible, and impactful project proposals that promote sustainability, equity, and nation development.

Participants are invited to pitch an original concept or innovation — whether it's a product, a service, a system, or a social model — that reflects responsible action and resilient thinking. From environmental initiatives and public health strategies to digital empowerment and inclusive education, your idea could be the spark that ignites positive change.

Guidelines:

- ▶ Each student must prepare and submit a synopsis of the project to dvcpinterconf@gmail.com
 1. Maximum page limit is 5
 2. Arial / Times New Roman font in 12 size with 1.5 line spacing
 3. Proper numbering of pages
 4. Pictures, tables, etc., should be appropriately referenced and titled
 5. Report in PDF format should be submitted with the following contents:
 - Title page
 - Declaration of originality (by the student and the principal)
 - Table of contents
 - Introduction
 - Objectives of the project
 - Analysis and presentation
 - Expected outcomes
 - Conclusion
 - Bibliography
- ▶ PPT slides for the presentation and discussion
- ▶ Duration: 5 minutes, followed by Q&A

General Instructions

- ▶ Each round will feature a prize (cash prize of ₹1000, certificate) for the top-performing participant.
- ▶ Cumulative scores from all three rounds will decide the best overall performer.
- ▶ A cash prize of ₹10,000, a certificate, and a memento will be awarded to the first prize winner.
- ▶ For the second prize, cash prize of ₹5,000, certificate and memento will be awarded.
- ▶ The top three performers in the research pitch will be selected to participate in the panel discussion scheduled for August 12th 2025.

DAY 2 : 12/08/2025 | Panel Discussion

The panel discussion will feature experts, selected research pitch participants, and the audience, focusing on diverse thematic areas identified under the main theme

1. Quality education

Group Dance Competition : Rhythms of India

General Guidelines:

- ▶ Theme Focus: Performances must reflect any aspect of Indian culture — including traditional festivals, folk tales, regional styles, unity in diversity, or cultural values.
- ▶ Team Composition: Minimum 7 and maximum 10 members per group.
- ▶ Time Limit: 5-10 minutes. 1-minute setup and 1-minute clearance time before and after performance. Points will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- ▶ Music: Must be submitted in pendrive.
- ▶ Attire: Costumes should align with the cultural theme of the performance.
- ▶ Props: Allowed, but must be managed within the time limit.
